ADMINISTRATIVE ASPECTS: Specific aspects of primary teachers' training related to admission, orientation, training and teaching-staff patterns.

ORGANIZATIONAL ASPECTS: Specific aspects of primary teachers training related to physical facilities, residential facilities, Library facilities, and institutional accommodations.

ACADEMIC ASPECTS: Aspects of primary teachers' training that includes course components, method of teaching, practice teaching, duration and size of the course and instructional materials.

EVALUATION ASPECTS: The process of measuring the extent to which educational objectives of primary teachers' training have been achieved.

PTI: Abbreviation of Primary Training Institute

CERTIFICATE-IN-EDUCATION: One year pre-service training of primary school teachers offered by PTIs. In precise it is known as C-IN-ED.Course.

HIGHER CERTIFICATE-IN-EDUCATION: The course is designed for Head masters of primary schools as administrative training offered by PTIs. This course is known as H.C-IN-ED.Course.
