**CHAPTER III**  
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The present study was carried out with the broad objective of studying the effectiveness of imparting food safety education to food service providers of urban Vadodara and to determine ways of reducing microbial load on coriander leaves. The specific objectives of the study included:

- ① To conduct baseline survey of the owners of the food service providers of small and medium restaurants, dhabas, railway food outlets, bus stand food outlets and fast food joints on their food safety related knowledge and practices.
- ② To sensitize the various stakeholders for establishment of street food court so that the trained street food vendors could be placed to provide safe food to the public at large.
- ③ To study the effectiveness of imparting Food Safety Education (FSE) to the Street Food Vendors (SFVs) and owners and handlers of small and medium restaurants and also to see the effect of follow up training imparted to SFVs.
- ④ To study the effectiveness of various disinfectants at different levels to reduce the microbial load of coriander leaves.
