The Gujarat University Library started its services in 1951. Starting off modestly in 1951 with 1,700 books and 170 periodicals in the temporary structure, the library moved to its current, new location in 1967. The library's architectural and structural design is like an unclosed book. The structure has 4 floors and a sizable basement with a reading room and a stack space. Gujarat University's

activities revolve around its library, which is true. For the purpose of acquiring and disseminating academic and research information to fulfil the university's current and future demands, Gujarat University has created one of the State's largest university library systems. Dr. Yogesh Parekh is current university Librarian. University library has reach and dynamic website with personal domain name – “https://glibrary.com”. Library is serving its users with majority Web 2.0 Services having integration of Web 2.0 tools in University library website. It has integrated FaceBook, Instant Messaging, Youtube Channel. Wiki and Faqs, Orchid ID for University, IRNIS, Live Web OPAC, Alongside this services University library has developed Institutional Repository “SAMPADA @ Gujarat University” with Dspace software and Library providing RemoteXS facility to its users.

On May 1, 1950, the Shrimati Hansa Mehta Library, the university library of The M S University of Baroda, was founded. A collection of 25,000 books from the two State Libraries (Huzur Political Office and Secretariat Library) were given to the University Library at the time the M. S. University of Baroda was founded. Baroda College (for Arts), Science Institute, Commerce College, Secondary Teacher's Training College, etc. were among the many colleges there. On May 1, 1950, the University Library System was founded and moved inside the Old Residency Office Building's central block. On November 16, 1954, Dr. Rajendra Prasad, the President of India at the time, lay the cornerstone for the Smt. Hansa Mehta Library at the Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda.

Currently Dr. Mayank Trivedi is working as University librarian. University library has reach and dynamic website with personal domain name - <https://www.hmlibrary.ac.in/>. Library is serving its users with majority Web 2.0 Services having integration of Web 2.0 tools in University library website. It has integrated Facebook, RSS, Instant Messaging service, YouTube Channel, Twitter, Instagram, Blog, Wiki page and Faqs, Academia.edu page, Research Gate, Orchid ID for University, IRNIS, Live Web OPAC, Android App of library. Alongside this services University library has developed Institutional Repository with Dspace software and Open Knowledge Gateway also. Library Online orientation link and Library registration link is also available on library website.




Figure 6-4 Smt. Hansa Mehta Library Website




Figure 6-7 SSSU Library website

Institutional Repository and Open Access listing and Open courseware along with subject gateways on its website.




Figure 6-9 Learning Resource Center Website

## 6.6 Central University of Gujarat (CUG) – Central Library

Established by Parliament of India through the Central Universities Act (2009), Central University of Gujarat (CUG) considers its main objectives to be dissemination and advancement of knowledge creation and sharing. economically underprivileged sectors who are unable to purchase computers or laptops separately access to computers and the internet. CUG has successfully adapted to the internet era by expanding its collection of online publications to 8000+. Several databases are also accessible through the library.




Figure 6-11 Website of Central Library CUG




Figure 6-13 Website of LRC




Figure 6-15 Website of The Lilavati Lalbhai Library - CEPT




Figure 6-17 NU Library Website

IRNIS, Telegram and Mapping Services. Library is automated with SOUL software and having Live Web OPAC and Institutional Repository.




Figure 6-19 GU Library Website

## 6.11 Dhirubhai Ambani Institute of Information and Communication Technology (DA-IICT) – Resource Centre

The DAIICT Resource Centre (RC), the library, links users to the appropriate information sources. In teaching, learning, and research tasks, it acts as a creative collaborator. RC is located in two buildings with wi-fi that are roughly 16000 square feet in size and can house about 300 users at once. There are around 31020 books, 11230 e-books, 5674 e-journals, 78 print journals, 10 databases, 663 theses, and 3913 audio visual materials in the ICT, social science, and humanities available at the Resource Centre. A web-enabled online catalogue can be used to search this collection. The dedicated computers in the reading zones also allow students to browse and access a variety of electronic resources, including e-books, e-journals, and databases.




Figure 6-23 Website of Library & Learning Resource Center




Figure 6-25 Website of B U Tarsadia Learning Resource Centre




Figure 6-26 GSFC University library




Figure 6-29 Website of PU library




Figure 6-32 Central Library PPSU




Figure 6-33 Central Library - PPSU
