O R D E R:

At present, Hindi is a Compulsory subject for the students appearing for S.S.C. Public Examinations and the marks obtained in the subject is being taken into account for the purpose of calculating the aggregate to marks. For recruitment to Central Services such as Post and Telegraphs Department etc. the aggregate of the marks obtained in the S.S.C. Public Examination is considered for recruitment. In States like Tamil-nadu Hindi is not a compulsory subject, and it is not being considered for aggregate marks. This has put Andhra Pradesh students in a disadvantageous position as Hindi is also taken for purpose of aggregate marks, since it is a compulsory subject.

2. The Commissioner for Government Examinations who was consulted has stated that the matter was placed before the Board of Secondary Education and it was resolved that While taking into account the performance in Second Language for a Pass, the marks need not be included in the aggregate as was done in the case of S.S.L.C. Examination.

3. After careful consideration, Government approve the resolution of the Board of Secondary Education and Direct that the marks awarded in Hindi in SSC. Public Examination shall not be included in the aggregate marks.

4. The following amendment is issued in G.O.Ms.No.63' Edn., dated 16-1-1969.

AMENDMENT

The following shall be added as item XIX of S.S.C. Scheme approved in the said G.O.

"Though II Language is a compulsory Examination subject, the marks secured, shall not be included in the aggregate marks".
